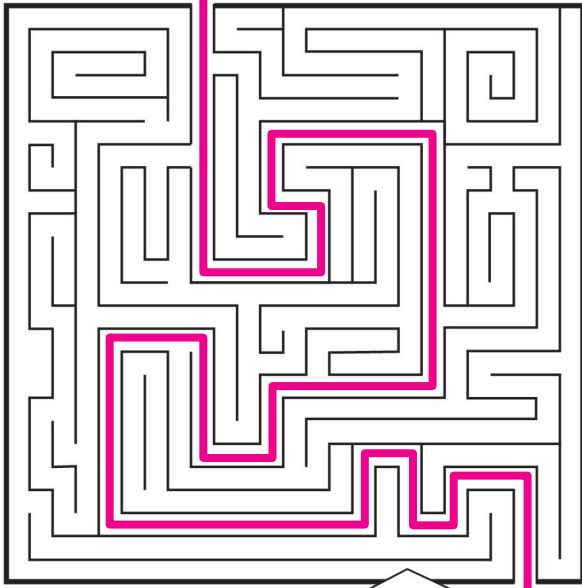

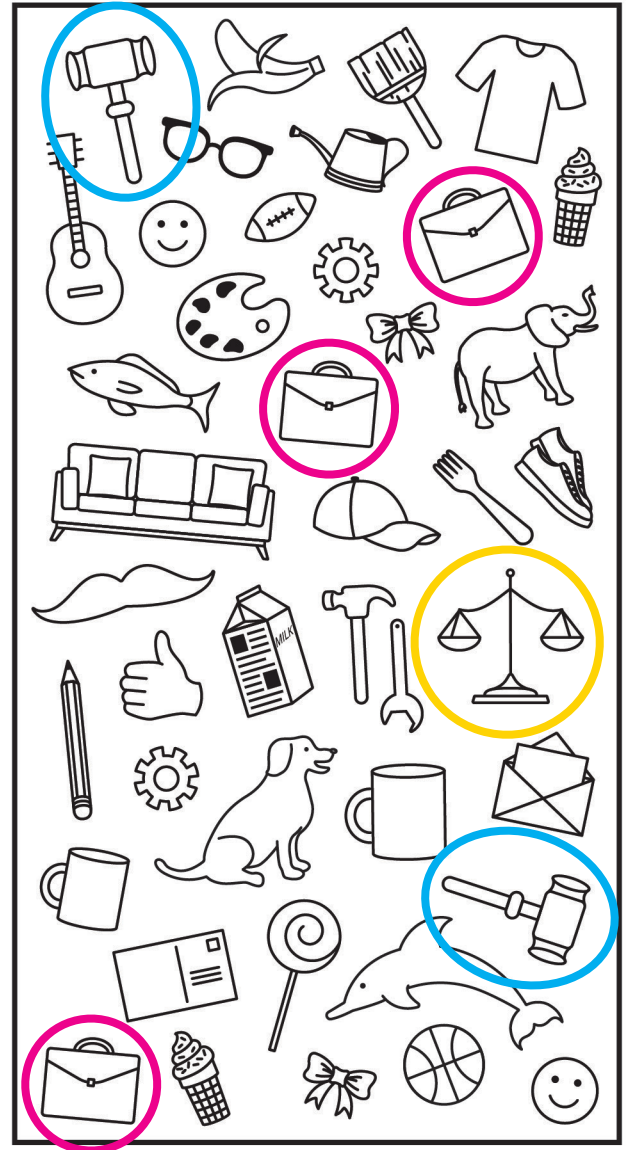
Across
